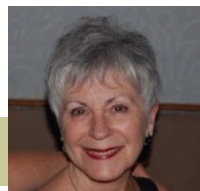

## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

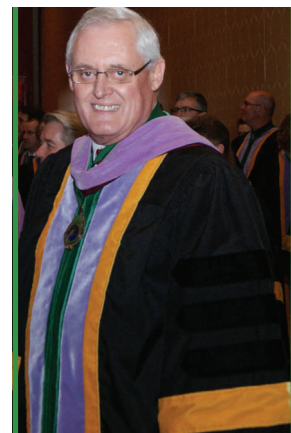

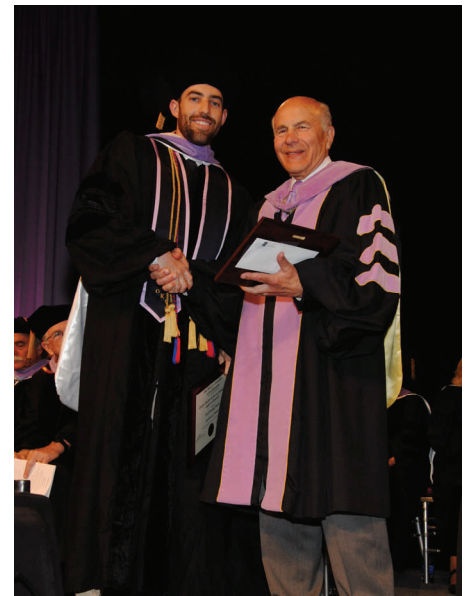

I want to let you know that the USA Section of the International College of Dentists is very active in promoting the ICD as well as continuing to develop and implement a variety of activities and programs. We are more effective, efficient, and productive in our efforts. Visit our website and [www.usa-icd.org](http://www.usa-icd.org) to get the latest information about the USA Section as well as how to nominate Fellows.

The following list provides a short summary of recent USA Section activities:

- The fellowship **nomination process is completely electronic** now including all supporting letters and Board of Regent votes. This has made the entire process much more efficient, simple, and easy. We now have **on-line dues payment** options.
- We have **updated our Bylaws**.
- We continue to implement our **International Student Exchange Program** whereby dental students from the USA visit other countries and experience their dentistry and culture. Students from the foreign schools likewise visit the USA. We just completed a **survey** for our "10 years and less" ICD Fellows.
- We have initiated a **Century Club** ICD Foundation effort that encourages US Fellows to give the Foundation \$100 per month. So far we have almost \$50,000 for 2015 and all Board of Regent and Board of Trustee members are donors. We encourage you to become a Century Club member.
- We are very much enjoying our **new Section Office** in Gaithersburg, Maryland. It is a large, modern, and functional facility...which is good because we continue to increase our Section Office staff.
- We are financially supporting the **ADA's Humanitarian Award** and its **Annual Session MOM** clinic.
- We met with the **ACD and ADA to discuss annual meeting logistics** and will continue to meet with the American College to assess this further.
- We are developing a **Performance Policy** for USA ICD leaders as well as **positional guidelines** for those particular positions.
- **Our 2015 Convocation will be Friday, November 6, in Washington DC.**
