Organization

The International College of Dentists was established in 1920 by Dr. Louis Ottofy of the United States and Dr. Tsurukich Okumura of Japan and incorporated in 1928. Its purpose was to promote cordial relations within the dental profession and help disseminate scientific information.

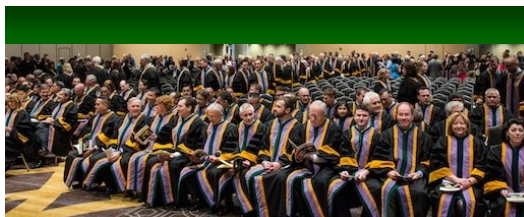

- At least five years in his/her dental career
- Membership in a national dental organization recognized by the USA Section Board of Regents
- An active contributor to the dental profession and/or community
- High integrity and character
- A graduate of an ICD recognized dental school
- Approved by the Board of Regents

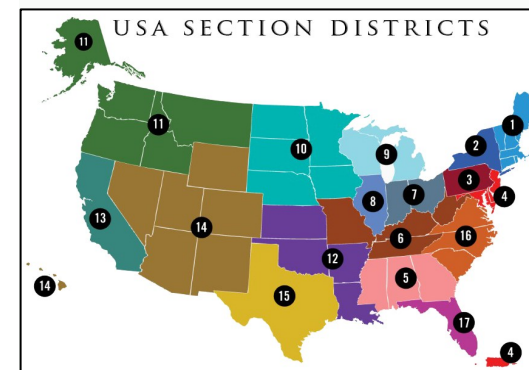
The qualifications of a Candidate are evaluated by Board of Regent Fellows during the screening process. Approximately four percent of American dentists are offered Fellowship in the International College of Dentists with over 6,500 members in the USA Section and roughly 11,000 total members worldwide.
