I would like to thank everyone everyone for the warm welcome I received as I stepped into the role of Registrar for the USA Section. I am looking forward to a productive and exciting year!



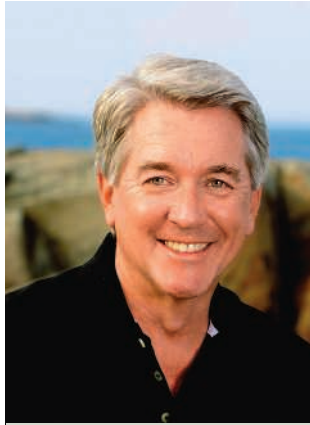

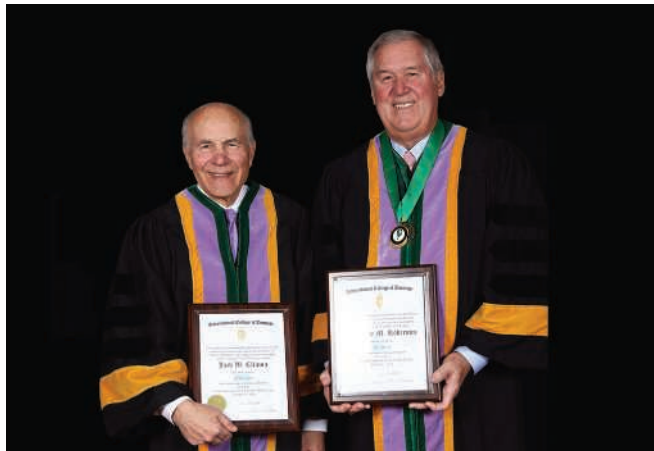
