The USA Section Board of Regents met April 29 through May 1 in Bonita Springs, Florida. Following the board meeting, two outstanding C.E. presentations were offered. On May 2, ICD Fellow Dr. Frank Serio presented the seventh seminar of a national "tour" on the ABCs of Humanitarian Volunteerism, sponsored tuition-free by the USA Section Foundation to all interested dental care individuals. If you have not had the opportunity to attend one of these superb presentations, you still have opportunities at future major dental meetings across the nation. If you have even a casual interest in volunteering your talents and expertise in a humanitarian effort here or abroad, this seminar is a must.

On November 30, Dr. Serio will present at the Greater New York Dental Meeting in New York City. Dr. David Frost will be the presenter at the Metro Denver Dental Society on January 23, 2015. Dr. Sam Molind does the honors on March 20, 2015, at the Western Regional Dental Conference in Phoenix, and Dr. Frost will be the speaker at the Star of the North Meeting in St. Paul in April, 2015. The second C.E. offering was held in Florida on May 3 and was presented by ICD Fellow and acclaimed endodontist, Dr. Diwakar Kinra. Dr. Kinra's scientific-grounded presentation on current endodontic procedures, protocols, and materials was informative and extremely pertinent to those of us involved with endodontic issues in our practices.

Prior to the C.E. events, the Board voted to realign the current USA Section committee structure. The number of Section standing committees will be reduced from seventeen to eleven. No services or programs were eliminated. Rather, committees were realigned to better reflect each program's focus on particular projects and services and eliminate duplication of efforts. Committees will be reviewed every two years by the Board with regard to current relevancy to the Section's core values and its strategic plan.

The USA Section Regents continued their dialogue in respect to increasing the number of new Fellows inducted each year. We vitally need the infusion of junior Fellows who will be active and engaging in our membership. Qualified dentists are all

around us. I URGE every Fellow to identify at least one qualified candidate and sponsor him/her for ICD Fellowship. If this was to happen (and I believe it can!), this great College could be transformed into a College with the ability and the resources to achieve unbelievable goals.

It is hard to believe that my year as USA Section President is almost half completed. It is a fantastic experience. The International College of Dentists USA Section 2014 Annual Board of Regents Meeting on Thursday, **October 9** and Convocation & Dinner Program on Friday, **October 10** will be held at the **Grand Hyatt San Antonio**, 600 E. Market Street, San Antonio, TX 78205, in conjunction with the ADA 2014 Annual Session. We **strongly** encourage you to secure your hotel reservation in our **ICD group block** at the Grand Hyatt San Antonio through the ADA Housing Bureau. Experient, as soon as possible. To register **please enter this link** in your web browser; www.ada.org/session.

- Click on **Registration** near the top of the page. Scroll down and click the **Register Now box**. Then click the **Green Register Now Box**.
- AVOID clicking the Back button during the registration process. Doing so requires you to start the process over from the beginning.
- Under Group Code type ICDSAT (all caps), then click Proceed.
- Under Registration Categories, choose appropriate category. Then type in ADA Member Number "or" use Dentist Lookup Search boxes and click Find Me. Click Select for your name.
- Verify/fill out your Profile including the question(s) below your email address, then click "Next".
 Verify Address Confirmation, then click "Next".
- ADA Continuing Education and Events are optional. Click "Next" at bottom of each activity. Please Verify Registration Summary page. You may register other attendee(s) at bottom of this page. Click "Next".
- Choose arrival and departure dates and click "Search" In Room Search, select our hotel at top of list, Grand Hyatt San Antonio (600 E. Market Street). If the block fills, you will see "Sold Out", but if rooms are still available for attendees outside the block, you will be able to select a room at our hotel in the alpha listing. If you see a red "W" by the hotel you will be placed on a wait list for one or more nights. Experient will send you an updated confirmation email when the room becomes available. If room block for one or more of your days is CLOSED, you will see the "Sold Out" symbol and you will not be able to book the room. If this occurs you may book a room at a nearby hotel.

Our ICD block of rooms will be held until June 27, 2014 or until rooms are exhausted. After June 27 or once rooms are exhausted – whichever should occur first - rooms will be assigned on a space available basis at our assigned hotel or at a nearby hotel if space is not available at our assigned hotel, Grand Hyatt San Antonio. For this reason, we strongly encourage you to complete online housing and/or registration as soon as possible.

Should you wish to register and/or make hotel reservations utilizing the HARD COPY form, you may do so by writing our ICD Group Code-ICDSAT - in the top, right corner of the registration and hotel reservation form. ADA Annual Session Advance Registration and Refunds

Advance registration saves time and money, and ensures access to the largest number of ticketed courses. Advance registration for the Annual Session closes at 5:00 pm Central Time on Friday, September 5, 2014. After September 5, 2014 all fees will increase and registration badge materials will not be mailed. Registration, ticket and/or special event cancellations must be received in writing on or before September 5. Registration or ticket cancellations received by this date will receive a full refund, less a \$10 processing fee per cancellation.
